Attendance Reminder

Parents/Carers are responsible for:

- Ensuring that their child attends school regularly and punctually unless prevented from doing so by illness or attendance at a medical appointment.
- Contacting the school office on the first morning of absence (before 9.30am).
- Informing the school in advance of any medical appointments in school time. For the absence to be recorded as a medical absence we do require evidence from the doctor or dentist. (Appointment card/letter). Where possible, ALL medical appointments should be made outside of the school day.
- Making requests for authorised absence in term time, only if absolutely necessary as these are not automatically authorised.
- Talking to the school as soon as possible about any child's reluctance to come to school so that problems can be quickly identified and dealt with.

Authorised absence

An absence is classified as authorised when a child has been away from school for a legitimate reason and the school has received notification from a parent or carer. For example, if a child has been unwell and the parent telephones the school to explain the absence.

Only the school can make an absence authorised. Parents do not have this authority. Consequently, not all absences supported by parents will be classified as authorised.

Unauthorised absence

An absence is classified as unauthorised when a child is away from school without the permission of the school.

Therefore, the absence is unauthorised if a child is away from school without good reason, even with the support of a parent.

After School Clubs

Information on the after-school clubs for next half term (Autumn 1) will be on ParentPay shortly.

We do not like increasing payments and have kept the cost the same for many years now, but unfortunately, we have had no choice but to increase the cost per lesson for violin, clarinet, drum and guitar tuition to £5.00 per session (Pupil Premium is £2.50). Orchestra Club will increase to £2.00 per session (£1 Pupil Premium) from September 2023.

Next half term, Monday's after school club will be Gymnastics and Tuesdays will be Mixed Sports. We are awaiting confirmation from Grassroots, who run these clubs, as to the costs.

Please remember that you must enrol your child, via ParentPay, before they attend Gymnastics and Mixed Sports Clubs.
