Dear Parents/Carers

I hope you and your families are well. As we approach the end of our first half term next week I would like to update you on a few changes and other updates or news across school.

Next week Mrs Mills our Year 1 teacher will be leaving St Joseph's. Mrs Mills started teaching at St Joseph's in September 2005 and I know we will all be very sad to see her leave. I am sure she will have taught many of your children and she even taught one of our current teachers here at St Joseph's when she was at a previous school! I will keep you guessing who this teacher is!

Mrs Mills has had a huge impact on our children's lives she has such an engaging presence, her commitment to our school sees her helping to improve the confidence of children, their self-esteem and she has always encouraged them to do their best. Mrs Mills will be a huge miss but as she takes up a new career working to develop safety education in the police force we wish her all the very best and I am sure we will be calling on her new skills to enhance our teaching of safety outside of school.

Mrs Gillingham will also be taking a break from school as she begins her maternity leave sometime in the next half term and we will keep you informed of this date. We have begun the recruitment process for their posts and will again keep you up to date with any new appointments.

In the shorter term we will secure a supply teacher to ensure we provide a consistent teaching process for our Year 1 children. We do have a number of support staff vacancies that have also been advertised so we are hoping to introduce these new staff who will be joining us to you all, again when the recruitment process is complete.

#### Harvest

Harvest Festival is being celebrated throughout the month, where farmers and growers give thanks for a successful harvest season. Last year during the harvest season, schools made a real difference to families across their areas, by collecting food and delivering it to charities that can give it to those who need it most. We also understand that a telephone consultation may suit some of our parents, particularly those who work, so we will also be offering this option.

If you would like a face to face appointment, please come into school next week to make this booking. If you would prefer a telephone appointment, please email sjmoffice@stjosephssunderland.school advising of a preferred time, your child's name, class and contact details (parents name and telephone number). The teacher will attempt to call you at some point within the hour, depending on the number of face to face appointments they may have during that time. If they are unable to call you at your preferred time, they will do so as soon as they can. Please note that if a telephone booking is made, it is likely that the teacher will phone you with NO CALLER ID shown. Please answer the call if this shows.

I would urge you all to book an appointment as it is an opportunity for you to discuss your child's progress this term. Teacher's will share information with you regarding how well your child is doing in school and any way that you can support your child at home.
