The topics we are learning are Homes, Judaism, Promises and Visitors.

Maths

The topics we are learning are Place Value, Addition and Subtraction and Multiplication and Division.

English

Our class readers are Stone Age Boy, Iron Man, The Iron Age and Fantastic Mr Fox.

The genres we are reading and writing are a diary entry, instructions, adventure story, non-chronological report and poetry (riddle).

Personal Development

We are covering the British Values of – Mutual Respect, Tolerance and Rule of Law and Democracy.

Spanish

The topics we are learning about are Family Members, Animals, Numbers and Colours.

Our topics are Hockey and Gymnastics.

We are learning about the concepts of rests through pulse, rhythm, melody, listening and appraising, performance, singing and composition.
