Attendance Information

Attendance is monitored very carefully in our school - our target for all pupils is 97%+ attendance, this is to ensure your child is given the chance to achieve their potential academically. Improving attendance in school seen now as a national priority following a decline; per -pandemic levels have not been reached – there is an obvious correlation between attendance and attainment.

<u>Absence</u>

If your child is going to be absent from school, for example because of illness, you must call school with a reason for absence before 9.00am and each morning of absence after that. You can do this by simply leaving a message on the pupil absence line at any point before 9.00am – a member of staff may call you back to discuss the absence in more detail, and validate the absence. To avoid them having gaps in their learning, it is important that routine appointments for doctors, dentists, optician etc are made for after school where possible. Any unexplained absences will be recorded on our system as 'unauthorised'. Any pupils with persistent absences will be referred to the Local Authority attendance team, who will, when applicable enforce the legislation as detailed in the section 7 of the Education Act 1996.

Leave of Absence

As you may be aware the school does not authorise holidays, unless in exceptional circumstances - this is in line with guidance set by the Department for Education (DFE), which states schools should no longer routinely authorise holidays unless there are exceptional circumstances. Generally. The DfE does not consider a need or desire for a holiday or other absence for the purpose of leisure and recreation to be an exceptional circumstance. From September 2024 in line with changes to legislation – any holidays taken during term time will be subject to a referral to the Local Authority for consideration of a Fixed Penalty Notice – we have attached a leaflet which details this. We ask that parents support pupils in maintaining a high level of attendance and punctuality and make every possible effort to improve any irregular attendance.

Fixed Penalty Notices for irregular attendance at school Important information for parents

I OVERVIEW

Regular school attendance is vital for children to reach their full potential. If your child is absent for any reason, it is important that you communicate fully with the school. However new national guidance is to be implemented from September to manage irregular attendance at school.

Penalty notices are issued as an alternative to prosecution where parents have failed to ensure their child attends school regularly. They can be used in cases where absence has not been authorised by a head teacher and can be in respect of any unauthorised absence, irrespective of reason.

The notices are used to prevent the need for court action, for example, when support has not been engaged with or is not appropriate (for example, leave of absence during term time).

Changes from September 2024 are shown

Z LEAVE

Head Teachers are unable to grant leave of absence during term time unless there are **exceptional circumstances**.

Generally, a need or desire for a holiday or other absence for the purpose of leisure and recreation **would not** constitute an exceptional circumstance.

3 ABSENCE

A Fixed Penalty Notice may be issued if there are **5 days / 10 sessions** of absence in a period of **10 school weeks** (where absence has not been authorised).

A notice may be issued where the 5day level of consecutive absence has not been reached, for example, if there are several periods of leave.

4 AMOUNT

The <u>first</u> penalty notice is **£160** if paid within 28 days, reduced to **£80** if paid within 21 days.

A <u>second</u> penalty notice is **£160** to be paid within 28 days.

A <u>third</u> penalty notice cannot be issued. Legal action may result (for example, prosecution).
